How does SCRIP work? You purchase physical or electronic gift cards through our program for everyday expenses like gas, groceries, dining out, clothing, etc. These gift cards are sold to Mount Olive at a discounted price, and 60% of the rebate is distributed annually to your account based on your chosen option on your enrollment form. Options include: tuition credit, hot lunch credit (new in 2024), Tuition Assistance Fund, General Fund, Forward in Faith 2 Fund, cash payout (a check is issued to you in June with your earnings for the previous year), participants also have the option to earn funds for another family (i.e., grandparents can purchase SCRIP and apply it toward their grandchildren's accounts.)
