# Bible Passages for Lesson 3 of *Politics is Driving Me Crazy!*

## **Proverbs 28:2-12**

- <sup>2</sup> When a country is rebellious, it has many rulers, but a ruler with discernment and knowledge maintains order.
- <sup>3</sup> A ruler who oppresses the poor is like a driving rain that leaves no crops.
- <sup>4</sup>Those who forsake instruction praise the wicked, but those who heed it resist them.
- <sup>5</sup> Evildoers do not understand what is right, but those who seek the Lord understand it fully.
- <sup>6</sup> Better the poor whose walk is blameless than the rich whose ways are perverse.
- <sup>7</sup> A discerning son heeds instruction, but a companion of gluttons disgraces his father.
- <sup>8</sup> Whoever increases wealth by taking interest or profit from the poor amasses it for another, who will be kind to the poor.
- <sup>9</sup> If anyone turns a deaf ear to my instruction, even their prayers are detestable.
- Whoever leads the upright along an evil path will fall into their own trap, but the blameless will receive a good inheritance.
- <sup>11</sup>The rich are wise in their own eyes; one who is poor and discerning sees how deluded they are.
- <sup>12</sup> When the righteous triumph, there is great elation; but when the wicked rise to power, people go into hiding.

## Matthew 22:15-22

- <sup>15</sup> Then the Pharisees went out and laid plans to trap him in his words. <sup>16</sup> They sent their disciples to him along with the Herodians. "Teacher," they said, "we know that you are a man of integrity and that you teach the way of God in accordance with the truth. You aren't swayed by others, because you pay no attention to who they are. <sup>17</sup> Tell us then, what is your opinion? Is it right to pay the imperial tax<sup>[a]</sup> to Caesar or not?"
- <sup>18</sup> But Jesus, knowing their evil intent, said, "You hypocrites, why are you trying to trap me? <sup>19</sup> Show me the coin used for paying the tax." They brought him a denarius, <sup>20</sup> and he asked them, "Whose image is this? And whose inscription?"
- <sup>21</sup> "Caesar's," they replied.

Then he said to them, "So give back to Caesar what is Caesar's, and to God what is God's."

<sup>22</sup> When they heard this, they were amazed. So they left him and went away.

## 1 Timothy 2:1-7

<sup>1</sup> I urge, then, first of all, that petitions, prayers, intercession and thanksgiving be made for all people— <sup>2</sup> for kings and all those in authority, that we may live peaceful and quiet lives in all godliness and holiness. <sup>3</sup> This is good, and pleases God our Savior, <sup>4</sup> who wants all people to be saved and to come to a knowledge of the truth. <sup>5</sup> For there is one God and one mediator between God and mankind, the man Christ Jesus, <sup>6</sup> who gave himself as a ransom for all people. This has now been witnessed to at the proper time. <sup>7</sup> And for this purpose I was appointed a herald and an apostle—I am telling the truth, I am not lying—and a true and faithful teacher of the Gentiles.

## **Deuteronomy 24:1**

<sup>1</sup>If a man marries a woman who becomes displeasing to him because he finds something indecent about her, and he writes her a certificate of divorce, gives it to her and sends her from his house...

## Matthew 19:1-9

- <sup>1</sup>When Jesus had finished saying these things, he left Galilee and went into the region of Judea to the other side of the Jordan. <sup>2</sup> Large crowds followed him, and he healed them there.
- <sup>3</sup> Some Pharisees came to him to test him. They asked, "Is it lawful for a man to divorce his wife for any and every reason?"
- <sup>4</sup> "Haven't you read," he replied, "that at the beginning the Creator 'made them male and female,' [a] <sup>5</sup> and said, 'For this reason a man will leave his father and mother and be united to his wife, and the two will become one flesh' [b]? <sup>6</sup> So they are no longer two, but one flesh. Therefore what God has joined together, let no one separate."
- <sup>7</sup> "Why then," they asked, "did Moses command that a man give his wife a certificate of divorce and send her away?"
- <sup>8</sup> Jesus replied, "Moses permitted you to divorce your wives because your hearts were hard. But it was not this way from the beginning. <sup>9</sup> I tell you that anyone who divorces his wife, except for sexual immorality, and marries another woman commits adultery."
