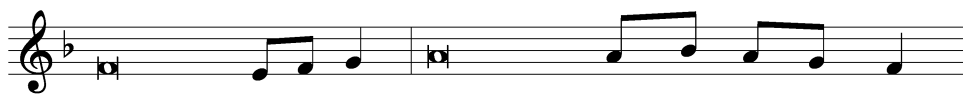
Silence for meditation and reflection

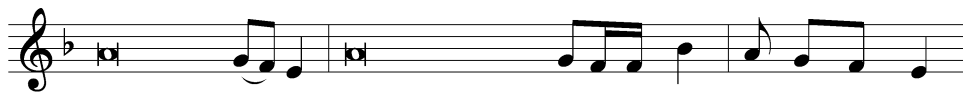

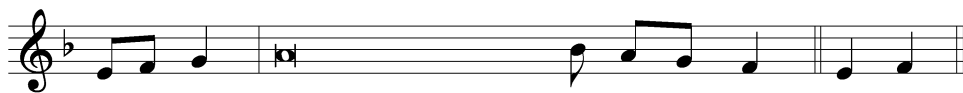
