

The Word Works—to Help Us Persevere through Persecution July 7-9, 2018

- (2 Timothy 3:10-15) You, however, know all about my teaching, my way of life, my purpose, faith, patience, love, endurance, {11} persecutions, sufferings--what kinds of things happened to me in Antioch, Iconium and Lystra, the persecutions I endured. Yet the Lord rescued me from all of them. {12} In fact, everyone who wants to live a godly life in Christ Jesus will be persecuted, {13} while evil men and impostors will go from bad to worse, deceiving and being deceived. {14} But as for you, continue in what you have learned and have become convinced of, because you know those from whom you learned it, {15} and how from infancy you have known the holy Scriptures, which are able to make you wise for salvation through faith in Christ Jesus.

- 2. In what way have you experienced persecution in your personal life?

- 3. What forms of persecution did Paul experience? (cf. Acts 13:49-14:20; 2 Corinthians 11:16-29)
- 4. If a government official told you, "Renounce Christ or die," what would you do? (Make a list of thoughts that would go through your head.)

- 5. Why do you think that the Bible openly announces that Christians will be persecuted?
- 6. What "knowledge" has God given you to give you courage in the face of persecution?
- 7. Paul was a model for Timothy's faith life. Who has been a model for your faith life?
