

### Colossians 1:13-17

**<sup>13</sup> He has rescued us from the dominion of darkness and brought us into the kingdom of the Son he loves <sup>14</sup> in whom we have redemption the forgiveness of sin. <sup>15</sup> He is the image of the invisible God, the firstborn over all creation. <sup>16</sup> For by him, all things were created: things in heaven and on earth, visible and invisible, whether thrones or powers or rulers or authorities; all things were created by him and for him. <sup>17</sup> He is before all things, and in him all things hold together.**
