

## Matthew 11:2-6

**<sup>2</sup> When John heard in prison what Christ was doing, he sent his disciples <sup>3</sup> to ask him, “Are you the one who was to come, or should we expect someone else?” <sup>4</sup> Jesus replied, “Go back and report to John what you hear and see: <sup>5</sup> The blind receive sight, the lame walk, those who have leprosy are cured, the deaf hear, the dead are raised, and the good news is preached to the poor. <sup>6</sup> Blessed is the man who does not fall away on account of me.”**



1. What question did John ask Jesus?
2. List 3 ways John could have found the answer to his question. How did John actually get his answer?
3. When Jesus answered John's question, he was referring to what God said about the Messiah in the book of Isaiah. Jesus reminded John that the Bible had an answer for his question.
4. When you have questions about Jesus what are three ways you could try to answer them? How does God want us to answer our questions?
5. What awesome things can you think of that Jesus did?
