(Philippians 2:5-11)

- ⁵ Your attitude should be the same as that of Christ Jesus: ⁶ Who, being in very nature God, did not consider equality with God something to be grasped, ⁷ but made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant, being made in human likeness. ⁸ And being found in appearance as a man, he humbled himself and became obedient to death—even death on a cross! ⁹ Therefore God exalted him to the highest place and gave him the name that is above every name, ¹⁰ that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on earth and under the earth, ¹¹ and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the glory of God the Father.
- 1. What has been a great thing about the past 2 weeks and what has been a hard thing?
- 2. What have we learned about humanity during these stressful days?
- 3. Where have you seen someone have the attitude of Christ Jesus lately?
- 4. v. 6 says that Jesus made himself nothing, taking the very nature of a servant. Can you think of times when Jesus took the nature of a servant?

- 5. Based on your answer to question 4, in what specific ways can you have the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus?
- 6. v. 8 says that Jesus humbled himself. What earthly analogy might you use to describe the magnitude of Jesus humility?
- 7. What obstacles make it difficult for humans to take that humble attitude?
- 8. Dr. Phil and Judge Judy often tell people to fix their attitudes. Jesus died to take away your sins. How does that make his words different?
- 9. What would it be like to be quarantined with Jesus?
- 10. Agree or disagree: Life would be a lot easier if I had the same attitude as that of Christ Jesus.
- 11. In what ways would your life be different if you had the exact same attitude as Christ Jesus?(Consider your co-workers, church friends, your family and yourself?)
