Psalm 24

Of David. A psalm.

¹ The earth is the LORD's, and everything in it, the world, and all who live in it;

² for he founded it on the seas and established it on the waters.

³ Who may ascend the mountain of the LORD? Who may stand in his holy place?

⁴ The one who has clean hands and a pure heart, who does not trust in an idol or swear by a false god.

⁵ They will receive blessing from the LORD and vindication from God their Savior.

⁶ Such is the generation of those who seek him, who seek your face, God of Jacob.

⁷ Lift up your heads, you gates; be lifted up, you ancient doors, that the King of glory may come in.

⁸ Who is this King of glory?

The LORD strong and mighty,
the LORD mighty in battle.

1. What do you learn in this psalm about the world around you? (1-2)

- 2. What are the requirements for those who want to stand in the holy place with the Lord? (vv. 3-4)
- 3. What is meant by clean hands and a pure heart? (v.4)
- 4. In verse 4 "trusting an idol" could be literally translated, "lifting upyour soul to something worthless. Practically, what does that mean?
- 5. Martin Luther once said, "Whatever your heart clings to and confides in, that is really your god." A good thing can be a false god. Which common false god are you most tempted to elevate above God? *Success, Romance, Sports, Technology, Politics, Family, Morality*
- 6. What blessings are conferred on those who stand in the holy place with the Lord? Give a practical example of each. (v. 5)
- 7. Who is the King of glory? Work as a group to answer as thoroughly as possible. (vv. 8,10)
- 8. Use words or sketches to depict the King of Glory as described in this psalm. (BONUS CHALLENGE: can you include a detail from each verse of the psalm?)
- 9. Application: What do you learn from this psalm that will help you become a person after God's own heart?
