## Ephesians 5:15-20 (CSB)

<sup>15</sup> Pay careful attention, then, to how you walk—not as unwise people but as wise—

Rephrase:

**Pastor –** Walk = practical living. Many people tell you how to walk. **Application:** What are some characteristics of a wise walk?

<sup>16</sup> making the most of the time, because the days are evil. Rephrase:

**Pastor –** Hoard time because evil intensifies danger and need for Jesus. **Application:** Because of the evil days, I will use my time to...

<sup>17</sup> So don't be foolish, but understand what the Lord's will is.

**Pastor** – God wrote his will, both Law and Gospel. **Application:** Based on your situation, what is God's will for you? <sup>18</sup> And don't get drunk with wine, which leads to reckless living, but be filled by the Spirit:

**Pastor –** Remember Pentecost. **Application:** How is the Spirit's work like wine? How is it different?

<sup>19</sup> speaking to one another in psalms, hymns, and spiritual songs, singing and making music with your heart to the Lord,

**Pastor** – Music plays a crucial role in public and private worship. **Application:** Think of a song that elevates you. Who needs that today?

## <sup>20</sup> giving thanks always for everything to God the Father in the name of our Lord Jesus Christ.

Rephrase: \_\_\_\_\_

**Pastor –** Thankfulness is always a wise way to live (Romans 8:28). **Application:** Persuade me that God truly means *always* for *every*thing.
