

## Jesus is Glorified through Selfless Love May 1, 2022

John 13:31-35

- <sup>431</sup> When he was gone, Jesus said, "Now the Son of Man is glorified and God is glorified in him. <sup>32</sup> If God is glorified in him, <sup>a</sup> God will glorify the Son in himself, and will glorify him at once. <sup>33</sup> "My children, I will be with you only a little longer. You will look for me, and just as I told the Jews, so I tell you now: Where I am going, you cannot come. <sup>34</sup> "A new command I give you: Love one another. As I have loved you, so you must love one another. <sup>35</sup> By this everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another."

- 2. If the disciples had known on Good Friday what they learned on Easter evening, would it have changed their Good Friday? How?
- 3. When you think of God's glory, what comes to mind?

- 4. What was Jesus referring to when he said, "Now the Son of Man is glorified"?
- 5. Agree/disagree: Jesus was humbled, not glorified, by his crucifixion.
- 6. How does Jesus' "glory" on the cross impact your desire for glory?
- 7. Agree/disagree: There is nothing new about the command, "Love one another."
- 8. What does a Christ-like love look like in your life?
- 9. Why do you think that Jesus said that love for one another is the defining characteristic of his disciples?
- (10. What would be an appropriate prayer to offer on behalf of a Seminary student who is 3 weeks away from receiving his first call into the ministry?)
